

The borough engineer reported that a ditch on Glenwood avenue at Merchantville Terrace was dangerous as claimed in a letter from Mr. Rapp, of Delaware Township. It was agreed that the borough would pay 50 per cent of the cost of the material and that Delaware Township, which would receive the benefit of it, be asked to pay the other half.

The highway committee reported that the drainage conditions at Cove road and the railroad which has been the cause of complaint, would be remedied on Tuesday, when both the railroad and the borough would co-operate in the work.
