

Flooding was also reported in the 200 block of Glenwood Avenue, Merchantville, at 30th Street and River Avenue, Camden, and at the intersection of Route 70 and Springdale Road in Point-of-Woods, Cherry Hill. Heavy rains also caused a deep pool to form at the Freeway underpass on Route 130 in Gloucester City.

In Arthur Court Apartments, 1001 Black Horse Pike, Runnemede, water ran down the walls of the lower level of apartments, submerging rugs in up to one inch of water.
