The 200 block on Glenwood avenue, Delaware township, on the outskirts of Merchantville at Church road, was also flooded. Water ran into garages and cellars there also.

At Delaware avenue and Market street, the water rose over the curb causing pedestrians going to the ferry to walk up to Federal street before they could cross.

Second street and Atlantic avenue, usually one of the worst spots in Camden during a heavy rain, was only slightly affected.

On Church road, near State street, Delaware township, cellars were flooded and the low points in other communities were similarly flooded until sewers could carry off the water.
